## **EXCEL SHORTCUT KEYS**

*Tips for Excel Shortcuts found in Small Business Marketing Idea-Letter April 2008 issue*

Excel has no shortage of shortcut keys. Your productivity is sure to increase if you take the time to learn the shortcut keys for commands that you use frequently. In the following table, are some of the most useful shortcut keys. This list is certainly not an exhaustive one -- it describes just the commands found useful.

### **Shortcut**

**F11**

Create a new chart on a separate chart sheet by using data in the selected range.

**Alt+F1**

Create a new, embedded chart by using the data in the selected range.

**F5**

Display the Go To dialog box.

**Alt**

Display the key tips for the Ribbon commands so that you can access the commands by using letters on the keyboard.

Shift+F2  
Edit the comment in the active cell or insert a comment if the cell doesn't have one.

Shift+F10  
Display the shortcut menu for the selected item.

Ctrl+F6  
Activate the next window.

Ctrl+pgUp  
Activate the previous sheet in the workbook.

Ctrl+PgDn  
Activate the next sheet in the workbook.
